Background

Census 2020 Results

- 2010 Lenoir County Population – 59,495
- 2020 Lenoir County Population – 55,122

Census Bureau Block by Block Data

- Released in September
- Existing Lenoir County Districts were outside of the 5% overall deviation

One-Person / One-Vote Rule

- Districts need to be Nearly Equal in Population
- Rule of Thumb- “*No district should be more than 5% below or above the ideal population of exact equality*”
- All Districts must meet Voting Rights Act Requirements

New Redistricting Plan Must be Adopted 150 days before the next Primary

- March 2022

Affects Electoral Districts of the Board of County Commissioners & Board of Education

- Those elected by District



Redistricting Schedule

October 2021

- Redistricting Options Developed by County staff (GIS, *County Administration & County Attorney*)

October 18th

- Four (4) Redistricting Options are presented to the Board of Commissioners and the General Public
- County staff may evaluate alternative options based on discussion and direction from the Board of Commissioners

October 18th – November 1st

- Redistricting Options Publicly Available for Review and Comment

November 1st

- Public Hearing Held on Redistricting Options
- If there is a consensus among the Board members on a single option, the Board of Commissioners May Adopt a Resolution for the Selected Plan at this meeting **or** the following meeting on November 15, 2021 **or** an additional Special Called Meeting

November 17th

- Statutory Deadline for adoption of a Redistricting Option

- Posted on the County Website and Facebook Page
- Hard Copies Available at the County Manager's Office
- Public comment will be directed to the County Attorney



Redistricting Requirements

Must Contain 5 Districts

- No more than 10% population difference between largest & smallest district

Contiguity

- Precincts must touch and districts must not include “island” precincts

Minority Voting Rights

- Two majority-minority districts required



Potential Concerns & Considerations

Split precincts

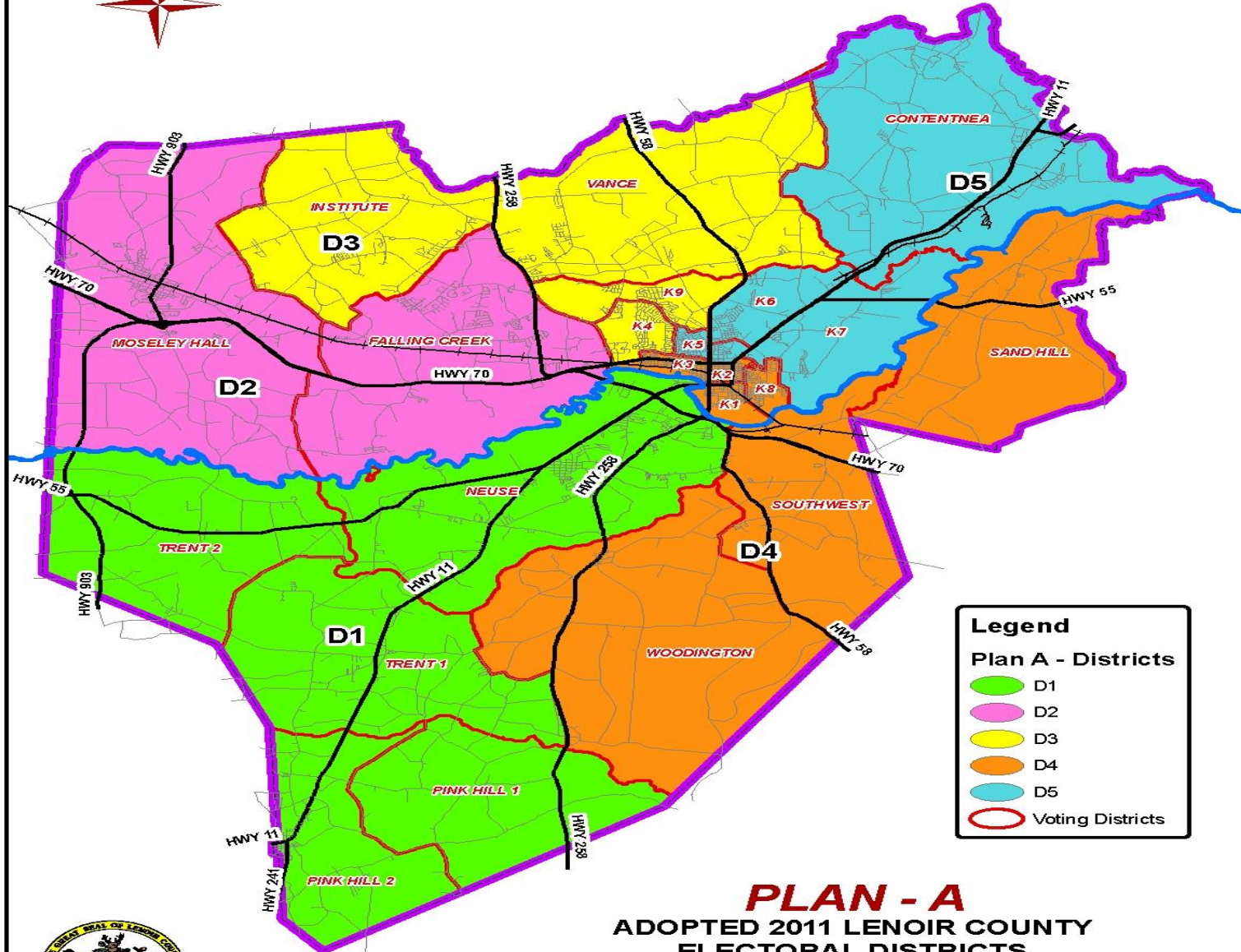
- Potential for voter and candidate confusion
- Use best practices (splitting by landmarks, roads, etc.) when necessary to split a precinct

“Double-Bunking”

- Avoid Pairing Incumbents

Drafter's Comments on Option 1:

- Pros:
- 1. No incumbents are forced to give up their seats, i.e., no "double bunking".
 - 2. Plan uses existing "familiar" precincts to compose each district.

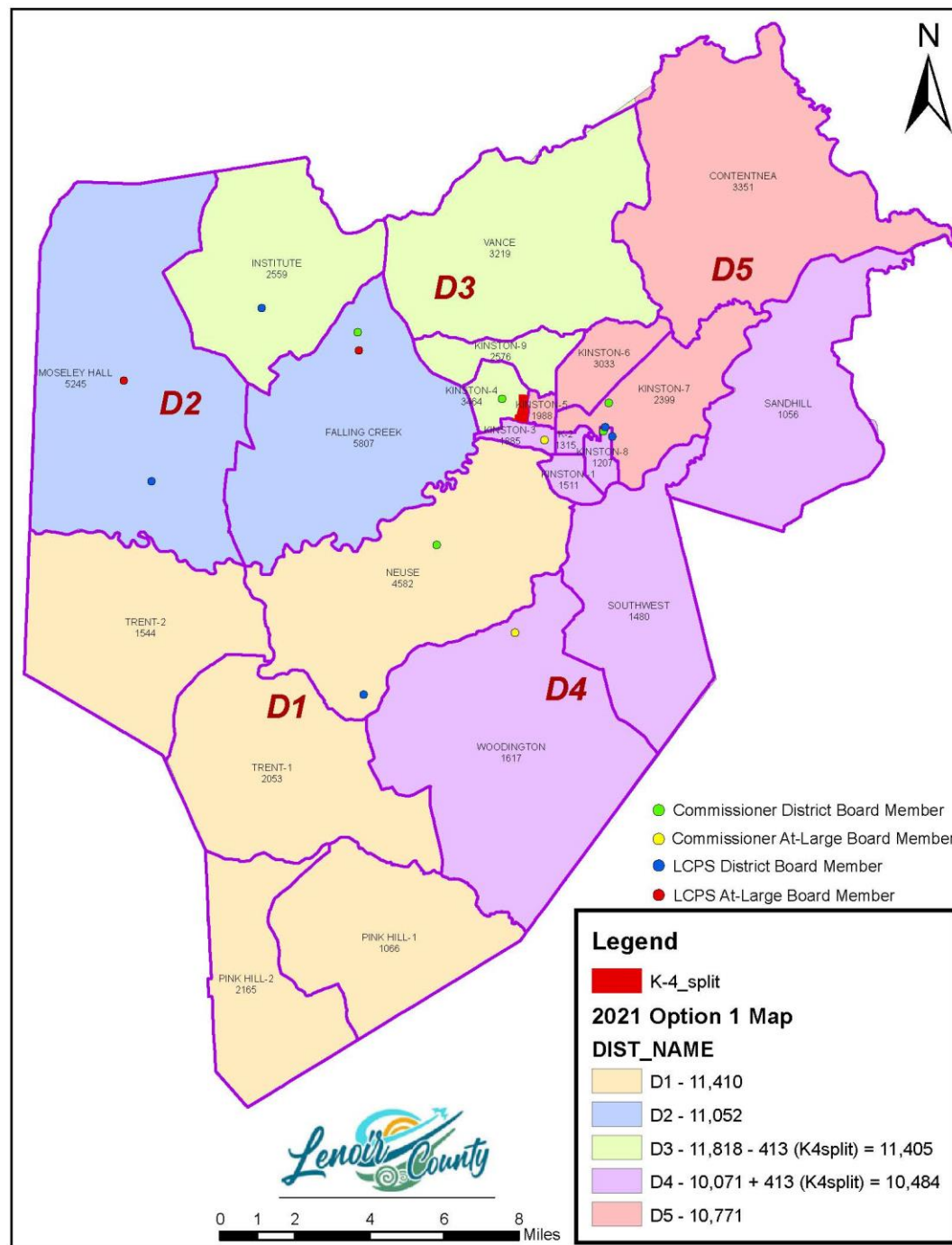
Cons:

- 1. District 4 gains 413 people at the expense of District 3.
- 2. Kinston 4 becomes a split precinct with the southern area between the golf course and Carey Road voting in a different district than the rest of the precinct.

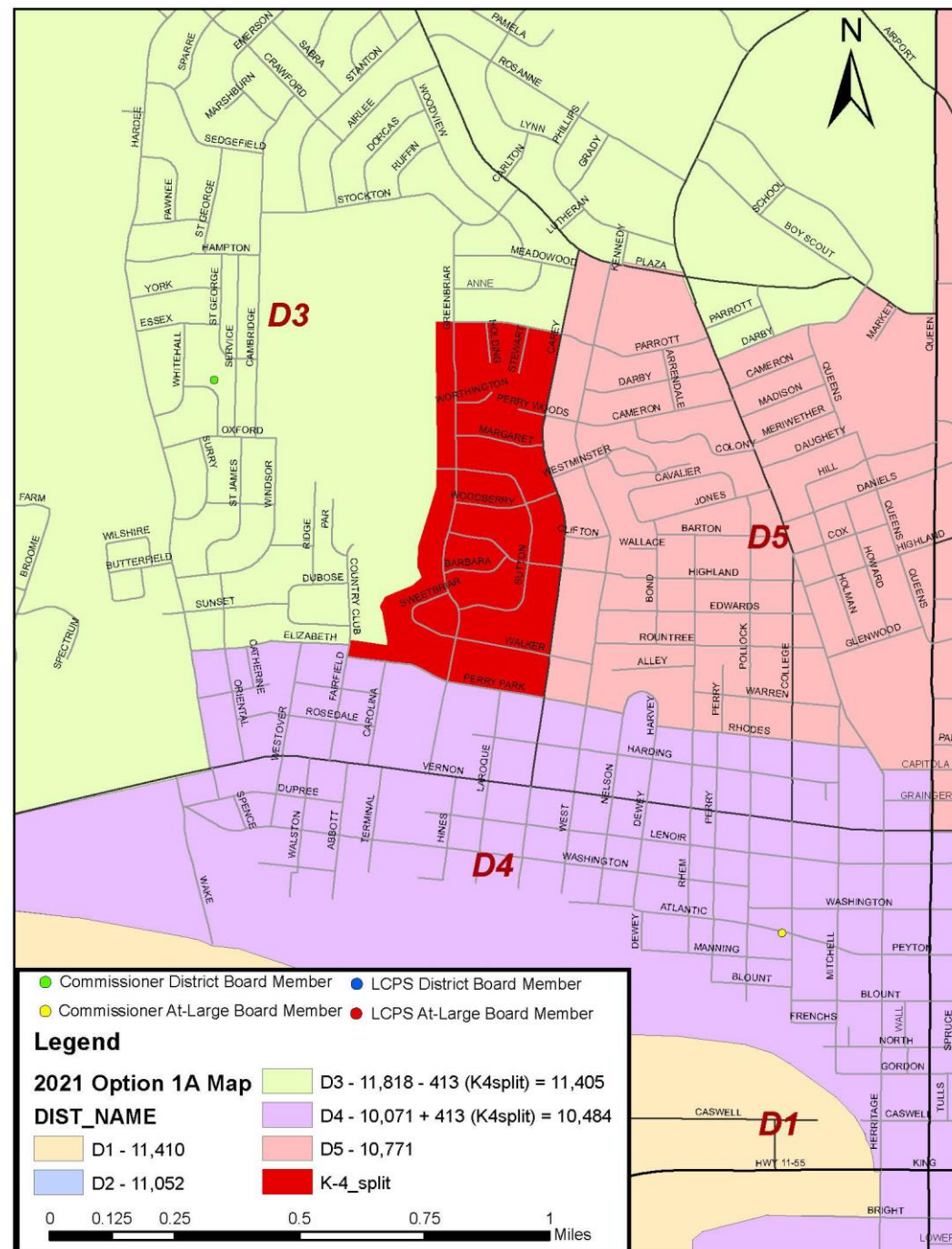


Option 1: Split Precinct Kinston 4

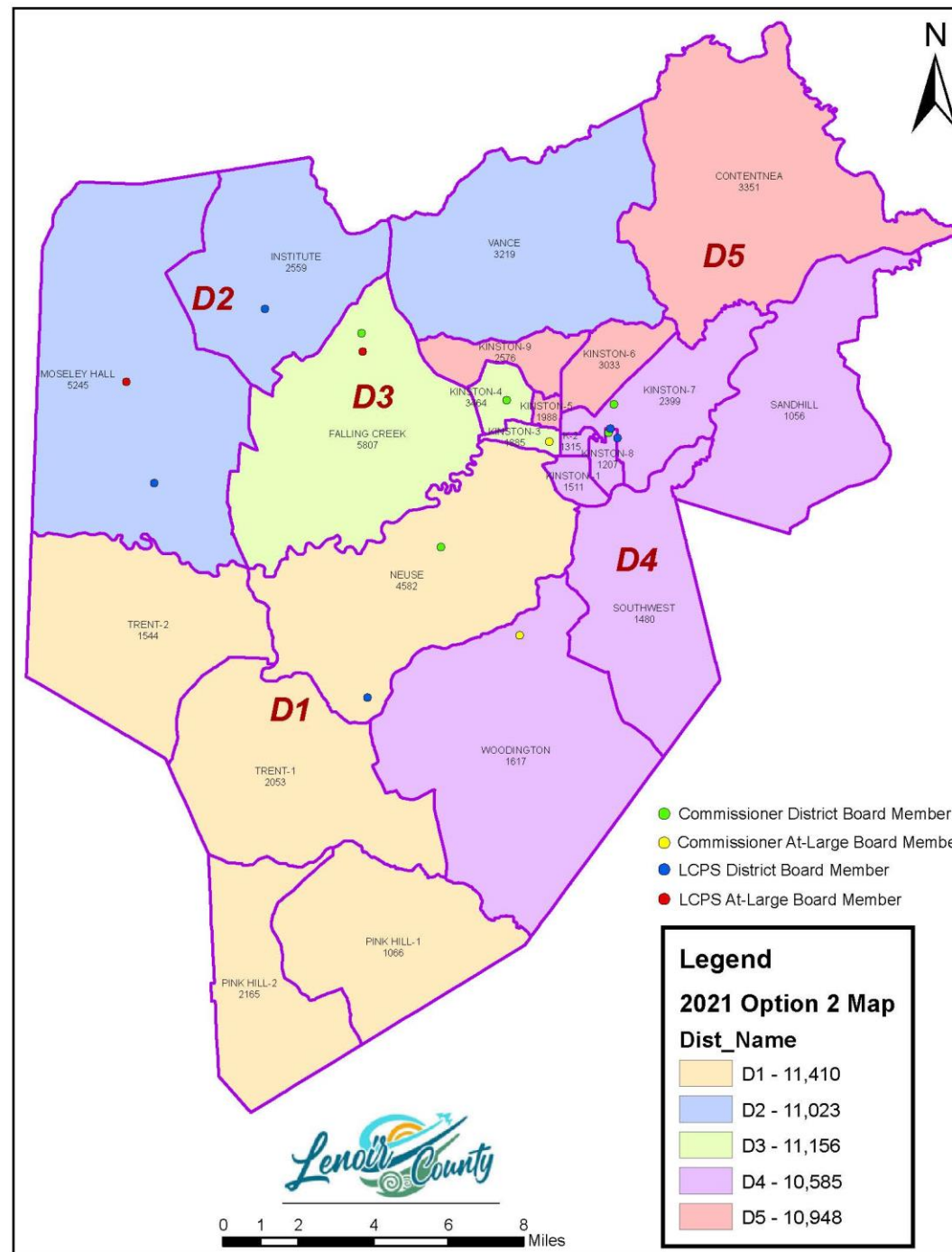

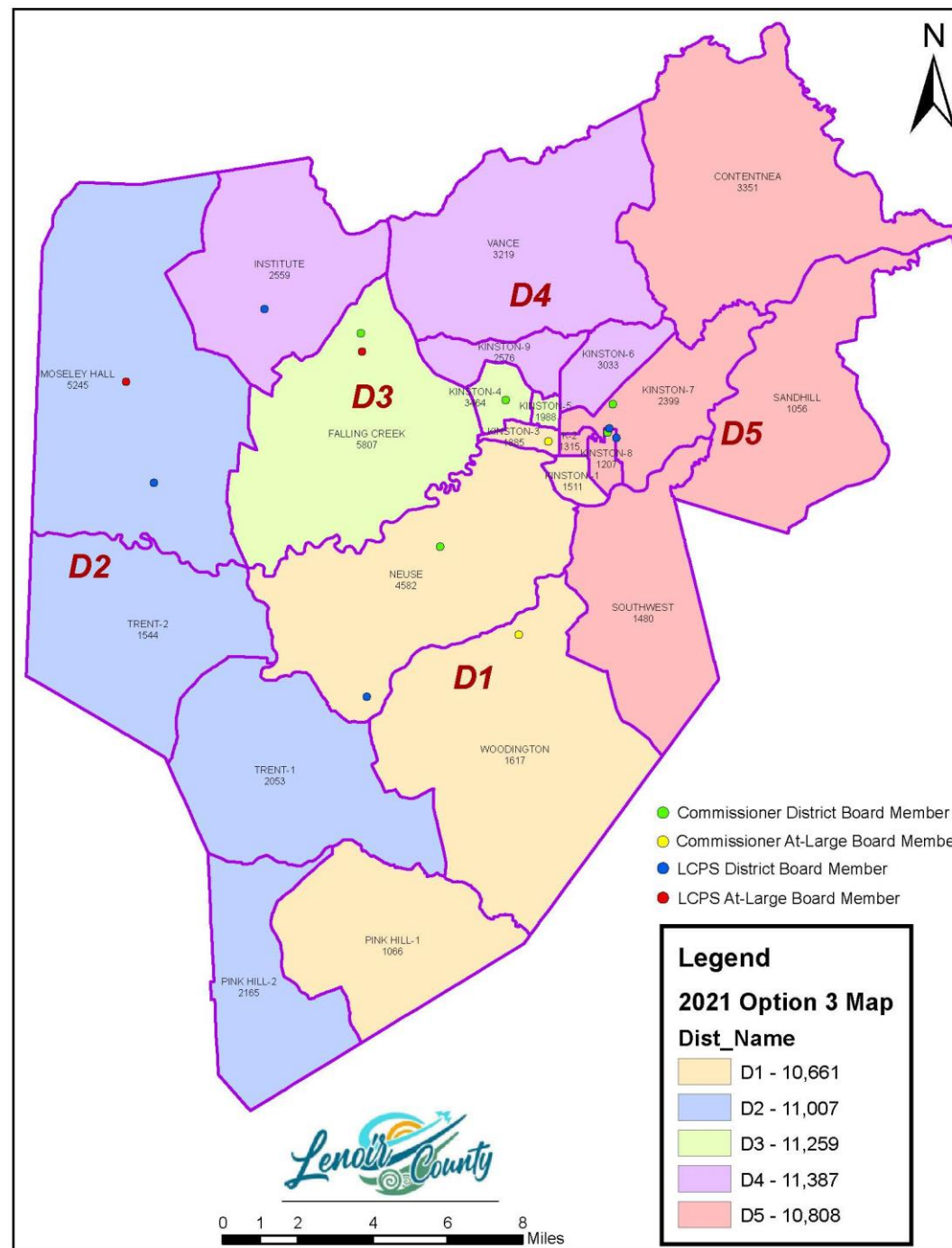

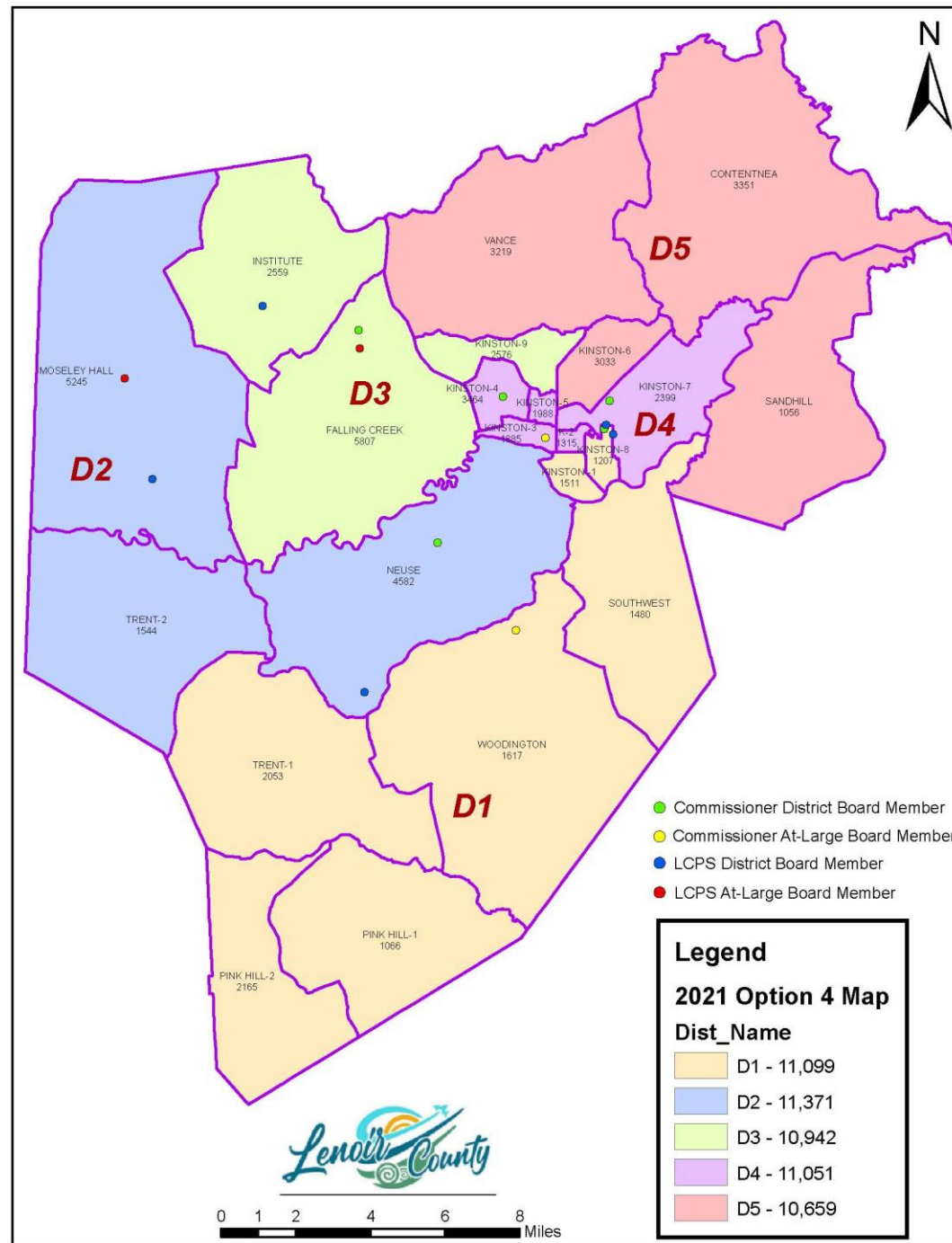

- 2. Plan uses existing "familiar" precincts to compose each district.

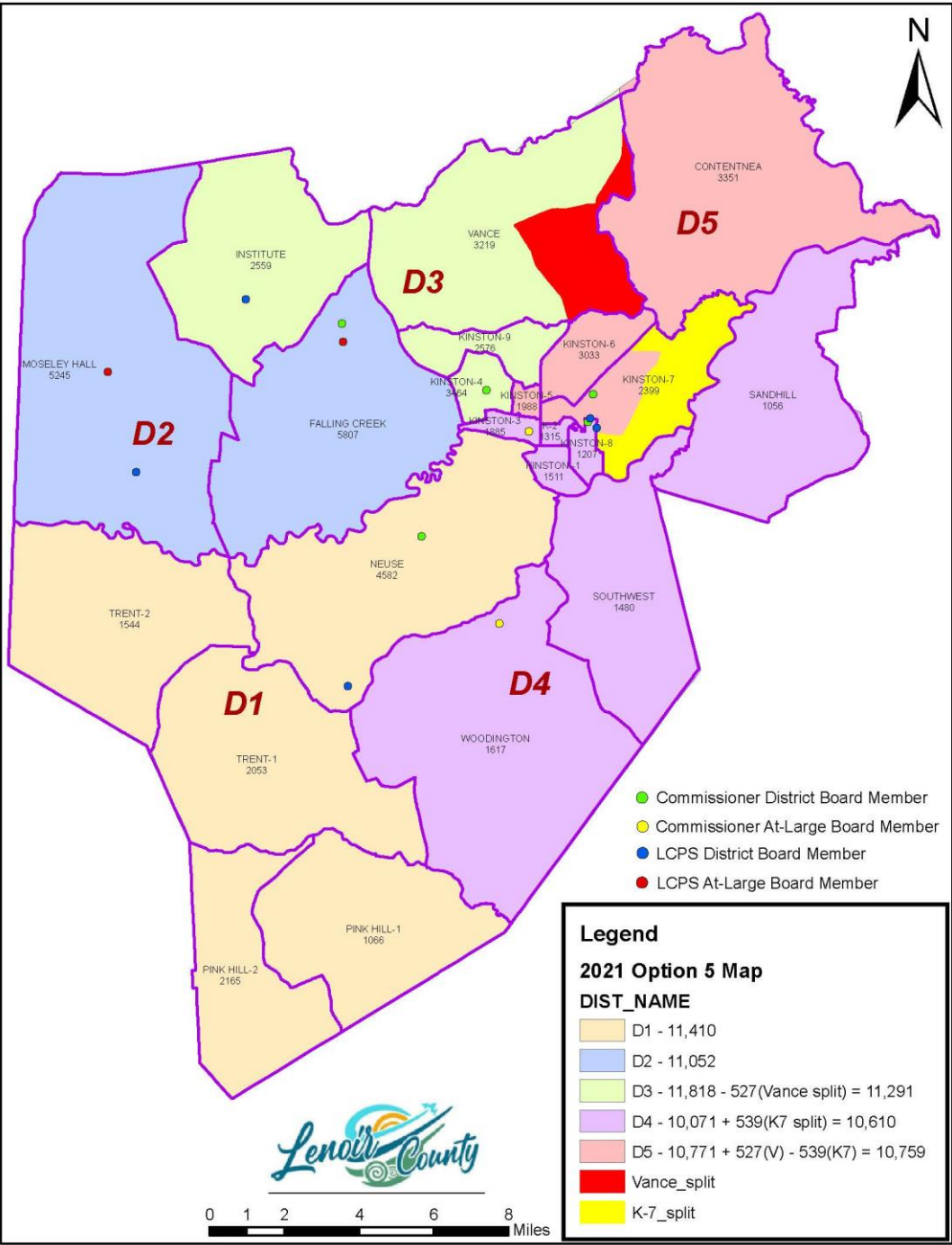
Cons:

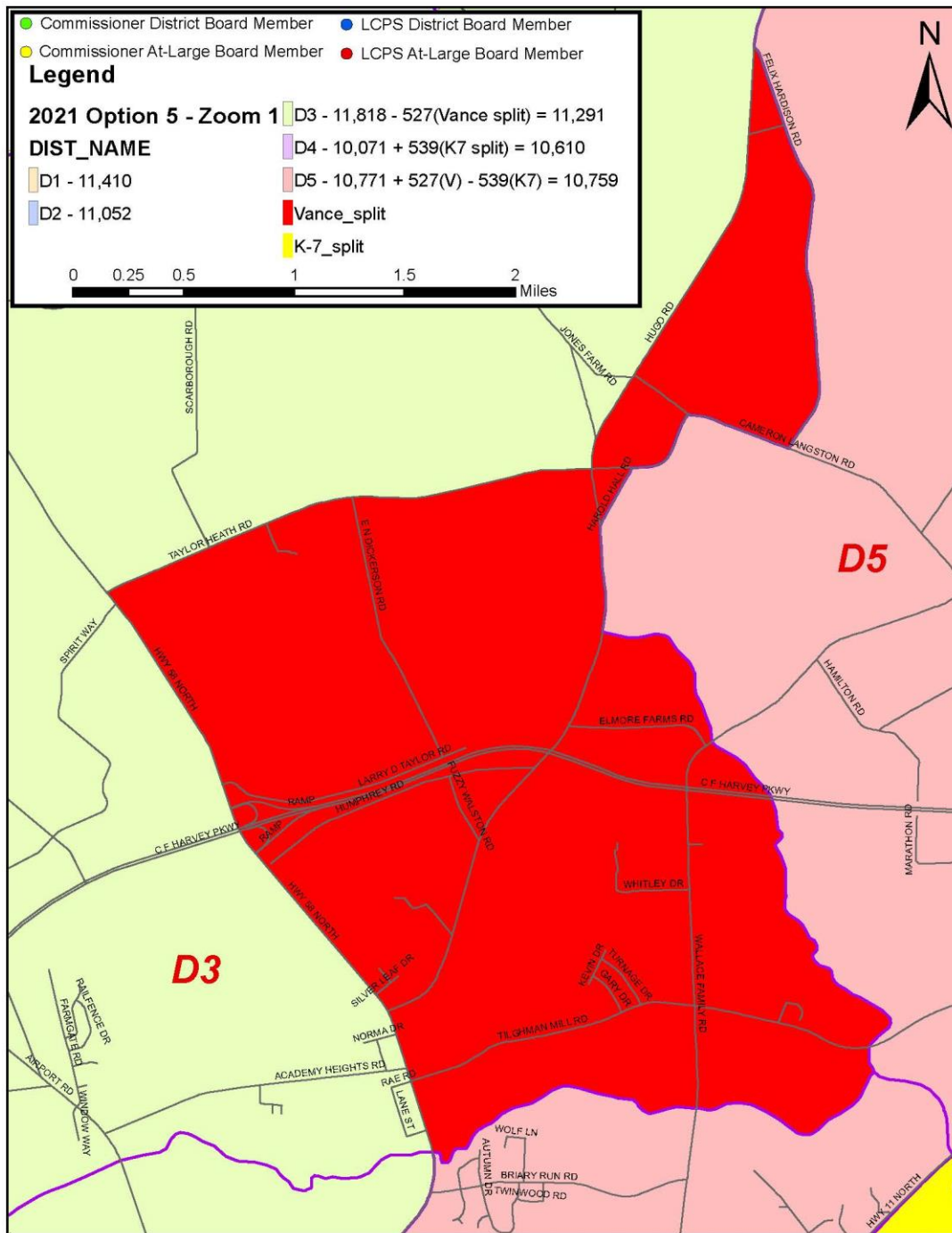
- 1. 527 people transferred from District 4 to District 5. 539 people transferred from Dist. 5 to Dist. 4.
